## Business of the Month Montgomery Photographics

K. C. and Nova Montgomery currently own and operate Montgomery Photographics, Inc., an advertising agency that caters to the western and equine industries as well as the photography business. K.C. Montgomery began his career as a photographer back in 1984, although his passion for photography started during his college days at the University of Oklahoma. He pursued that passion through his love of horses by developing a style of equine conformation photography that became in high demand.

Today K.C. is the official contract photographer for the American Quarter Horse World Championship Shows (since 1998), the American Paint Horse World Shows (since 1996), as well as the former official photographer for the European Championships in Germany for almost a decade. K.C. has had the opportunity to work for clients throughout the United States, Germany, France, Switzerland, Austria, Belgium, England, and Brazil. K.C. currently serves on the board of directors of the Professional Photographers of Oklahoma. He is active in the association, competing in print competition

and has received multiple awards including the prestigious FUGI Masterpiece Award for his print “The Race” that scored a perfect “100” in competition. Two of his prints, including The Race, have been accepted in the Professional Photographers of America loan collection.

In 2006, K.C. was honored with a museum exhibiting his work at the American Quarter Horse Heritage Center in Amarillo, Texas. In 2007, K.C. became the Official Hall of Fame Illustrator for the National Reining Horse Association, creating the portraits for all the NRHA Million Dollar Sires and Million Dollar Riders that now hang in the NRHA Hall of Fame.
